Stallion Service Contract

The contract for the breeding season of _____ made and entered into by Fantasy Paso Fino, herein designated stallion owner, and _____ mare owner. This contract covers the stallion JLM's Jaranero, PFHA #24449, and the mare _____ PFHA # _____. The stallion service fee is \$2000.00 The amount of \$1000.00 will be paid upon signing of this contract (this includes a non-refundable \$350.00) and the balance will be paid when the mare shall be declared in foal at 30 days. In addition to the stud fee, the charge for the first semen collection and shipping is due to the veterinarian at the time of shipping.

The Mare Owner Agrees:

- a) To pay board as billed by the stallion owner at the current mare care fee of \$10.00/day, mare and foal care fee of \$12.00/day.
- b) To pay all charges for transportation, farrier, and veterinarian services in addition to the stud fee as billed.
- c) To pay all charges for transportation, farrier and veterinarian certifying that the mare is in good physical condition, free from infectious disease, and in sound reproductive condition prior to boarding, if applicable.
- d) Stallion owner will not be responsible for accident, disease, or death to the mare or her foal (if she has a foal).
- e) To provide a copy of the mare's registration with signed contract and to follow all requirements for foal registration.
- f) If breeding is accomplished by artificial insemination the mare owner agrees to assume the charges for semen collection, insemination, and semen shipment incurred by the stallion owner. A charge of \$100.00 for semen collection will be charged for mares bred on the stallion owner's premises in addition to mare care fees. A charge of \$250.00 for semen collection and air transportation will be charged for each semen shipment. This is payable upon receipt of the semen as billed by the veterinarian. The "Equitainer" is the property of the stallion owner and must be returned (at the mare owner's expense) within 3 days of the semen shipment. A charge of \$3.00/day will be charged if the "Equitainer" is not received before or by that time.
- g) To have the mare pregnancy checked by a licensed veterinarian and to have the status certified in writing within 30 days of the last bred and to notify stallion owner thereof.
- h) To grant a lien on the mare (and any foal conceived in this breeding) in the event payment of any portion of the stud fee or other charges are not timely paid, in the amount of the unpaid charges to the stallion owner and any legal fees incurred in the process. Also, no semen shipment will be made to the mare owner having an outstanding balance after 45 days and no mare will be included on the Stallion report sent to the PFHA if there is an outstanding balance as of December 31st.

The Stallion Owner Agrees:

- a) To insure that all care is taken to get mare "in foal" and provide documentation (at the mare owner's expense) to this effect if requested.
- b) To guarantee a live foal, provided that the mare is pregnancy checked by a licensed veterinarian who shall certify that mare to be in foal. In the event that the mare who was pronounced safe in foal does abort her foal or bears a foal which fails to stand as certified by a licensed veterinarian, the mare will have return breeding at no additional stud fee, good for the following calendar year only. In the event the mare owner fails to rebreed the following year, the stud fee and all other charges paid or not paid will be non-refundable.
- c) In the event the stallion should die or become unfit for service prior to the first semen shipment, or if the mare should die or become unfit for service (as certified by a licensed veterinarian) this contract shall become null and void and all monies paid as part of the stud fee shall be refunded to the mare owner. If after the initial breeding the mare fails to conceive, becomes unfit for breeding or dies, the stallion owner will refund one-half of the stud fee.

The Stallion Owner and Mare Owner mutually agrees:

- a) That if after three heat cycles the mare is not certified in foal by a licensed veterinarian, the stallion owner reserves the right to withdraw from this agreement and shall be granted release from further obligations.
- b) This contract shall not be transferred or assigned by the mare owner. This contract contains the entire understanding of the parties and any modifications or alterations or the terms and conditions must be in writing, signed by the stallion owner and mare owner.
